Laura has gained considerable experience working within a community rehabilitation team where the focus of her work was to provide intensive rehabilitation to clients following discharge from hospital and to assist them into reintegrating into their daily lives again and maximising independence and activity.

This involved assessing the functional and care needs of a wide range of client groups, provision of case management, crisis care management and multi disciplinary rehabilitation. She has been involved in a number of cases which have required extensive major adaptation and/or provision of specialist equipment to accommodate client needs and to promote their independence with various tasks around the home.

She also contributed to the Practice Educator working group and has experience of Practice placement education, for which she has completed formal training.

Recently she has undertaken a recognised Manual handling course for allied health professionals, provided by Physicare. She is an accredited facilitator and she has used these skills and this experience in a number of person handling assessments.
